The Greenwich Municipal Employees FCU is proud to announce that we will award one \$1,000.00 scholarship and six \$500.00 scholarships to high school seniors or full-time undergraduate students attending an institution of higher learning.

The attached package includes a qualification sheet and a two page application form to be completed by you. In addition, we will need an official transcript from your high school or college. **An official transcript is a transcript that is mailed directly to the credit union from your school. Hand delivered transcripts or copies of transcripts will not be accepted.** You can contact us to verify that we have received your transcript. Please make sure you request these forms early enough to receive them before the deadline.

When filling out the application, be certain you have given all the information requested. The Scholarship Committee will be reading these forms to find the person most qualified to receive this award. They will also be looking for neat, well written, completed applications. Remember, neatness counts!

Qualification Sheet

The Scholarship Committee has determined that the following criteria will be used to select the student to receive the award:

1. Applicant must be a credit union member or a child of a credit union member.
2. Applicant must be a full-time student currently enrolled in, or accepted to, a college/university undergraduate program.
3. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 grade point average.

Students must submit the following items with their completed applications. All items requested must be received in order for the application to qualify for consideration.

1. An essay on your career plans, qualifications and financial need must be demonstrated for this scholarship. The essay must be typed, double spaced and no more than two pages.
2. An **official transcript** of your high school or college grades. An official transcript is a transcript that is mailed directly to the credit union from your school. Hand delivered transcripts or copies of transcripts will not be accepted. You can contact us to verify that we have received your transcript.
3. Applications without an **official transcript** will be considered incomplete and not eligible for consideration.

Selection of the award recipients will be made by the Scholarship Committee. Applicants will be evaluated on essays, grades, financial needs, special needs and extracurricular activities.

Applications and accompanying material must be postmarked by **May 31, 2026**.
